


Baldwin Methodist College put up a magnificent performance showcasing their creativity as per the theme, as they were the hosts of fashion week.

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When students are not equal...

Favouritism, on the part of teachers, can affect a student's performance

Whatever the teacher is, it is more important than what he teaches, says psychologist Karl Menninger. An encouraging and affectionate teacher influences the lives of children. As a teacher's personality affects students' behaviour and their interest towards learning, it is vital for a teacher to be friendly and fair. Unfortunately, a few teachers develop favouritism for some students due to their academic ability, extra-curricular activities or sycophancy and give special attention to selected students. Sometimes, the problem becomes so intense that other students feel ignored. In most of the cases, the teacher does not even know that he is favouring some and denouncing others. Because of this, students may shy away from the class thinking that the teacher is showing them. Favoring one

student may have an unpleasant impact on the development of other students and can affect their future.
"When I was in high school, there was a teacher who would

favour only the talented students of the batch and would give them tips on how to prepare for exams. Whenever I approached him with my doubts in his office, I could see him helping his favourite students and he would answer my doubts lightly without any concerns. Because of him, I lost interest in the subjects he used to teach," says Vishalika, an engineering student.
Hanna, a first year MBA student at Ramiah Institute of Management Studies, feels that the teacher who favours a few students, can be good only for those students. But the teacher who doesn't have any prejudices is regarded as the best teacher and is loved by all. "Favouring a student does not make a teacher bad but it will surely have an impact on the entire class. While in school, I had a teacher who didn't like me. He would favour the girls who would inform about staff members and the happenings in school. Naturally, those girls used to feel superior to others. But when it came to teaching, he was the best I have ever

seen. I lost nothing because of his behaviour but if he was unbiased, I would have respected him more."
Joshua Samuel, Principal, Baldwin Methodist College explains that sometimes it becomes necessary to show preferential treatment to some students who have the potential for multi-tasking. "Favouritism always has a negative side to it. I personally do not encourage or practice it. But sometimes we have to entrust extra responsibilities to students who will be able to manage both



their studies as well as extra-curricular activities. As an encouragement and example for other students, it can be practiced but if carried to the extreme, it can have a disastrous effect. So, we always counsel the teachers on a regular basis to ensure that they are aware of the favouritism pitfall," he says.
"Each student is endowed with different abilities. A good teacher not only pays emphasis on academics but also appreciates other abilities in students. The purpose of the education is to help a student, not to show the student. Moreover, it is the need of equity among students with the favoured student feeling superior to others. He might be loved by his classmates, though not for his tasks. All the students should be treated as equals without any pre-determined biases," says Anusha Hegde.






The Mars Orbiter Mission (MOM), informally called Mangalyaan, is a Mars orbiter launched into Earth orbit on 5 November 2013 by ISRO. It is expected to enter orbit around Mars on 24 September 2014. The MOM probe was launched from Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh. The MOM probe spent about a month in Earth's orbit before trans-Mars injection on 30 November 2013.

It is India's first interplanetary mission and, if successful, ISRO would become the fourth space agency to reach Mars, after the Soviet space program, NASA, and European Space Agency. The primary objective of the Mars Orbiter Mission is to showcase India's rocket launch systems, spacecraft-building and operations capabilities. The secondary objective is to explore Mars' surface features and Martian atmosphere using indigenous scientific instruments.



10 SHOCKING FACTS ABOUT THE BERMUDA TRIANGLE

The **Bermuda Triangle**, also known as the **Devil's Triangle**, is a region in the western part of the North Atlantic Ocean, where a number of aircraft and ships are said to have disappeared under mysterious circumstances.



1. The first person to witness the strange activities in this area was Christopher Columbus, He stated that he saw mysterious lights and had difficulty with the compass as it did funny things.
2. The Bermuda Triangle is also known by the The Devil's Sea and also The Hoodoo Sea.
3. In alleged occurrences that happen in the Bermuda Triangle, there are often no signs of debris or anything to do with the object that has gone missing. This is said to be because the Gulf Stream runs the Bermuda Triangle and it can very quickly get rid of any debris, thus leaving no sign of any incident.
4. Possible theories include UFOs, the lost city of Atlantis, a Wormhole and even natural reasons like bad weather.
5. The most famous case to date of the Bermuda Triangle is the disappearance of a plane called flight 19 and also search planes that was sent out to try and find them. Combined 27 men and 6 planed were never found. This happened in 1945.
6. The area of the Bermuda Triangle is said to be around 440,000 miles of sea. This is an area much larger than Texas, Louisiana and Oklahoma combined.
7. There have been approximately 1,000 lives taken in the past 100 years, apparently caused by the Bermuda Triangle. Not all of these in suspicious circumstances, but it just goes to show that it is tricky to navigate the area.
